BOARD POLICY

No. 1110

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Number of Members, Qualifications, and Terms of Office

The board shall consist of five members, elected by ballot by the registered voters of the district. Except as otherwise provided by law, board members shall hold office for terms of four years and until their successors are elected and qualified. Terms of board members shall be staggered as provided by law.

A person is legally qualified to become a board member who is a United States citizen, a qualified voter in the district, and a resident of the director district.

The term of office for newly-elected directors shall begin at the first official meeting of the Board of Directors following certification of the election by the county auditor and the director taking and subscribing to the oath of office.
