## BOARD POLICY

No. 1112

### THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

#### Residency

A board member must remain a resident of the school district to continue serving on the school board. If a board member's residence changes to a place outside the district, the board member must resign and eligibility to serve as a board member ends with the change of residence.

If a board member's residence changes to a place outside of the board member's director district, but within the school district, the board member may continue serving on the school board until the next regular school district election (fall of odd numbered years), at which time an election will be held to fill the board position for that director district. If the change of residence occurs after the filing period for the regular school district election, but before the election, and the board member is in the first two years of his/her term, the board member may continue serving on the school board for the remainder of the full term as long as residency within the school district is maintained.

If a board member's director district boundaries are redrawn during his/her term resulting in the board member residing outside of the redrawn director district, the board member may serve out the remainder of the full term.
