THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Oath of Office

According to statutory provision, each new director shall take an oath to support the constitutions of the United States and the state of Washington, to promote the interests of education, and to faithfully discharge the duties of office to the best of his/her ability. The oath will be administered prior to adjournment of the board meeting following the certification of the election. A school district officer or notary public authorized to administer oaths must certify this oath and the signature of the member. After being properly completed, the oath of office shall be filed with the county auditor.
