Board-Superintendent Relations

The successful operation of schools requires a close, effective working relationship between the board and the superintendent. The relationship must be one of trust, good will, and candor. As the legally designated governing body, the board retains final authority within the district. The superintendent is the board's professional advisor to whom the board delegates executive responsibility for the operation of the district.
