### THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

#### Commitment to Long-Range Planning

The board of directors recognizes that providing high quality education for all students and increasing student achievement require clear focus, intentional planning, alignment of resources, thorough implementation and regular assessment of results. The board of directors commits the district to long-range planning to provide direction for accomplishing identified goals. Planning will enable the district continually to improve education within the discipline of the planning process.

The long-range plan adopted by the district will be subject to and be consistent with the constitutions and statutes of the United States and Washington State. Board policies, administrative procedures and management decisions will be measured against and be consistent with the long-range plan. Annual school/department improvement plans and board goals will complement the district's long-range plan.

Through the planning process, the board affirms its commitment to continuing, active involvement with the parents, staff, students, and community. The district's planning, implementation, and evaluation processes will incorporate parent, staff, student, and community participation as well as opportunities for public input.
